

# Notification of Vacancy

**Position:** Drill Team Advisor

3. The successful candidate must conform to all the rules and regulations associated with athletics and Morgan High School as well as the Utah High School Activities Association. In order to remain as an advisor, the successful candidate must demonstrate an understanding of the role of competitive athletics in the district's attempts to education the whole student.
4. The advisor must be available for early morning practices during the school year, summer activities in preparation of a new school year, competitions, spring tryouts, and periodic performances away from Morgan.
5. If two candidates are considered to be equal in their qualifications, the district will choose the person who is currently an employee of the school district and a member of our certificated staff.
