Dear Parents:

A suspicious circumstance was reported to the Morgan County Sheriff's Department yesterday involving a grey or white pickup truck in the Mountain Green Elementary School attendance zone. The male driver of the truck attempted to talk to students as they exited the bus. No student has been harmed and this letter is simply an attempt to inform you as parents of the incident and avoid a repeat of such an occurrence. This event also reminds us that all children should know how to handle this type of situation.

This month Morgan Elementary School, Morgan Elementary PTSO, and the Weber/Morgan Health Department are celebrating "Green Ribbon Month." This activity encourages student safety each day as we commute to and from school. The Mtn. Green event reminds us how important it is that children are aware of their own personal safety and surroundings throughout the day. At this time, please remind your child to take specific precautions including traveling in groups as they walk to or from the bus stop or school. If approached by a stranger, it is advised that all children escape the situation by any means necessary including screaming, biting, punching, and kicking. Students are then advised to immediately report the situation to an adult.

The Morgan County Sheriff's Department has asked that anyone seeing suspicious activity involving a pickup truck matching this description immediately call 911. The police dispatch will try to obtain a detailed description of both the driver and the vehicle. Unique and identifiable information such as a license plate number is very valuable information.

Please help us be vigilant regarding student safety by discussing this event as appropriate with your student tonight.
