Policy ABC Parent Selection Process for District Committees

The Morgan Board of Education values the input of parents.

All district committees are required to have parent representation. Parents who serve on district committees will be parents who have been elected to serve on individual school community councils. Parents who serve on school community councils are:

- a. Elected by other parents as representatives.
- b. Knowledgeable of the needs of the school, students, and employees.
- c. Familiar with the day-to-day operations of the school.
- d. Collaborative with school personnel.
- e. Involved in school decisions.
- f. Representative of all the individual communities in the district.
- g. Familiar with the financial operations of the school.

A parent who is not an elected member of a school community council may be selected by the Morgan Board of Education to serve on selected committees as a parent member *at-large*.

Process for Selecting *At-Large* Parent Representatives for District Committees:

1. A parent should notify the school principal, in writing (e-mail), of his/her desire to serve on a district committee.
2. The principal will send the request to the Superintendent.
3. The Superintendent will notify the Board.
4. The name(s) will be presented at Board Meeting twice annually – August and January.
5. If more than one at-large parent is interested in serving on a specific district committee, the Board will conduct a drawing during board meeting to select an *at-large* parent representative for a specific committee.
