Media Center/Library Book Selection

The Morgan School District Board of Education has the duty to select instructional materials that best correlate to the core standards for Utah public schools and graduation requirements. (UCA 53G-4-402(1(a)). Educators are responsible to ensure the selection and use of their materials complies with Morgan School District policies and directives.

It is the policy of the Morgan School Board that school library/media centers provide:

- 1. A wide range of library/media books and materials in a variety of formats, with diversity of appeal, and the presentation of different points of view.
- 2. Access to materials based on appropriateness to the level of the user in accordance with State guidelines.
- 4. School book selections for the media center/library made by the school media specialist with approval from the school principal (or designee) and school community council.
- 5. Appeals of decisions made by school can be made to the district's curriculum committee.
- 6. Appeals of decisions made by the district curriculum committee can be made to the Morgan Board of Education.

This same policy applies to individual classroom libraries.
