Here is a list of things you can expect to see in the coming weeks:

November 21, 2017	The Morgan Board of Education will certify the bond election results.
December 2017	Based upon specs from the architects, requests for bids from sub-contractors will be issued by the construction manager.
December 2017	A <i>Memorandum of Understanding</i> between the Morgan School District and Staker-Parsons for a roadway leading to the new middle school will be finalized. The road will be deeded to Morgan County when completed.
December 2017 – January 2018	If bids come in lower than projected, the Board will consider items that were removed in an effort to reduce costs. District employees and parents from each school’s community council will be invited to provide input.
December 2017	Zion’s Public Finance will consult with the Board to determine timelines for issuance of the bonds and strategies to obtain low interest rates.
February - March 2018	Weather permitting, ground work on each project will begin. The construction area at MHS will be fenced.
May - August 2018	Portable classrooms located in the parking lot behind MHS will be relocated to Morgan Elementary School.
May - August 2018	The district technology hub has outgrown its current space in a portable classroom at MHS and will require a more secure and permanent location. The Board may have to build a suitable building for its investment in technology.
March 2018 - July 2019	The 18 month construction period for both projects.
January - April 2019	Staffing decisions for MGMS
June - July 2019	Demolition of old classrooms at MHS followed by the paving of new parking lot.
August 2019	Completion and occupancy of both buildings for the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year.
