

The Morgan School District will adopt a new schedule for the 2018-19 school year. Data relating to student attendance, teacher and administrative opinions, with parent and student input for the new schedule will be collected during the year. A committee of stakeholders will make a recommendation to the Morgan Board of Education at the end of the school year whether to continue with the new schedule, modify it, or change back to the current schedule.

Under the direction of the principal, teachers are required to be at school before the beginning of the school day and remain when school dismisses. These times could be expanded to allow for **Professional Learning Community Meetings (PLCs), Department Meetings, Faculty Meetings, Parent Consultation, and Planning Times** to compensate for certificated employees leaving at dismissal time on Friday. The principal, in collaboration with the school community, would have full autonomy in determining best practices within the schedule. Classified employees would work their allotted time each week.
