

Hello Parents,

As you have probably heard, the State COVID taskforce, the Governor, and the State Superintendent met earlier this week and have announced that the school dismissal, or soft closure, will continue through May 1, at which point they will determine protocols for the balance of the school year.

Our buildings will be open today and Friday from 8 to noon. Do be aware that there will be limited personnel there; this will primarily provide a drop-off and pick-up point for course materials. School offices will have minimal staff in the building, so please leave a voicemail or send an email.

If you have questions about a course, please email that teacher. If you have questions about technology or food services, please contact the respective administration. If you have questions about counseling services for your child, please contact your child's counselor.

Food services will continue as scheduled by each school through this week.

Next week (March 30-April 3) is Spring Break. Teachers, parents, and students are being asked to take a break from coursework as well so that we can all enjoy some self-care and de-stress.

Through April, buildings will only be open on Mondays from 8 to noon, but grab-and-go lunches will still be provided Monday through Friday for children up to age 18. If your child is also receiving breakfast, the next day's meal will be included in the lunch bag.

Details about the protocols for spring high school activities are being discussed. Administration is determining which fees will be refunded and which will be prorated. We will update you as soon as decisions are reached.

We understand that you are facing challenges with the current circumstances; many of our staff members are also parents or grandparents and are facing similar challenges. Please communicate your needs with them and administration.
